HARRIS COUNTY CULTURAL ARTS COUNCIL PRESENTS FLY DANCE COMPANY “Hip Hop Street Dancing Meets Classical Music on the East Side”

Fly Dance Company: The Gentlemen of Hip Hop is a world renown dance company that has been delighting audiences around the globe since 1995. Their expert delivery of hip hop dance with a classical flavor is a treat for music and dance lovers of any age! Fly expertly infuses multiple creative elements in its performance to create a whole new genre known as "theatrical hip hop."

Fly has graced the stages of such prestigious venues as Washington’s Kennedy Center, Jacob’s Pillow, Vail International Dance Festival, Lincoln Center in New York, and Bob Hope Theater, and most recently they performed at Miller Outdoor Theater at Herman Park.

“Now, I’m so excited that they're coming to the EAST SIDE!” said Michelle Bonton, Executive Director of the Harris County Cultural Arts Council (“HCCAC”). This will be the first of two performances Fly Dance Company will perform at HCCAC as their new home theater. The residents of the neighborhoods in unincorporated East Harris regularly drive long distances to other parts of Houston for quality entertainment. Tickets can be obtained via Evenbrite for \$25 and purchased at the door for \$35. It costs ten dollars more to meet with the dancers after the show.

HCCAC is transforming a former 20,000 sq./ft church into a multipurpose cultural arts venue on the Eastside of Harris County that includes a theater, art gallery, museum and event space that’s located 15 minutes from downtown.

Jorge Casco, Executive Director of Fly Dance Co., stated that “there is an untapped market with great potential for arts and culture events on the Eastside. I’m happy to bring our style of dance and entertainment to this wonderful facility.”
